

Post-Construction	Based on Secondary Sewer Plan report U19 produced by BOS in December 2005, this project will remove and replace (R&R) or rehabilitate approximately 5.66 miles of sewer pipes as part of the 60 Miles Sewer Rehabilitation and Replacement program of the Settlement Agreement Program. The project is located in West Los Angeles in an area bounded by Strathmore Dr. and Wilshire Blvd. to the north, Selby Ave. to the west, Comstock Ave. and Club View Dr. to the east and Santa Monica Blvd. to the south. More than 85% of the U19 reaches are over 70 years old.
